

### Distribution Requirements

#### Requirements #1 to #4 in Programs A, B and Requirements #1 to #5 in Programs C, D

All students are required to complete courses from the major divisions within the College of Arts and Science. These distribution requirements expose students to all areas considered important in the achievement of a liberal arts education. These requirements may be satisfied with courses selected from the following list of junior (100-level) courses. Certain senior courses may also be included.

The following conditions apply:

1. No course may be used simultaneously in two or more of the Requirements 1 to 5.  
For example, if FREN 122.3 and FREN 125.3 are used to fulfill the Language requirement, they may not be used to fulfill the Humanities requirement.
2. No more than 6 credit units from one subject may be used in Requirements 1 - 4 in Program Types A, B, or in Requirements 1 - 5 of Program Types C and D. For this purpose, courses which may be credited towards a specific major and honours program are usually considered to be courses from the same subject.  
For example, if ENG 110.6 is used in the Language Requirement, no other course in English may be used in the Humanities Requirement.
3. Senior-level courses that require 6 credit units of prerequisite courses which have been used in Requirement 1 in Program Type C may not be used to satisfy this requirement.  
For example, ACB 200.3 may not be used in Requirement 1 if BIOL 120.3 and 121.3, its prerequisite, has been used.

### HUMANITIES

Only the following courses meet the Humanities Requirement in Programs A, B, D, or the General Requirement in Program C:

Any senior-level Humanities course may be used provided that the prerequisite is met and not more than 6 credit units in one subject are used for the Humanities or Languages Requirements. Certain WGST courses may be considered a Humanities and/or Social Science. Refer to the course descriptions.

CLAS 103.3, 104.3, 105.3, and 106.3 may **not** be used to fulfill the Humanities Requirement.

Any senior-level Social Science course may be used provided that the prerequisite is met and not more than 6 credit units in one subject are used for the Social Science Requirement. Statistics courses in Social Sciences cannot credit toward the Social Science requirement (eg. ECON 204.6, PSY 233.3, PSY 234.3, SOC 225.3 and SOC 325.3, formerly SOC 240.3). Certain WGST courses may be considered a Humanities and/or Social Science. Refer to the course descriptions.

NRTH 101.3, PSY 101.3 may **not** be used to fulfill the Social Sciences Requirement.

Any senior-level Science course may be used provided that the prerequisite is met and not more than 6 credit units in one subject are used for the Science Requirement. Students may use only 6 credit units in mathematics and statistics toward the Science Requirement. STAT 244.3 or MATH 102.3 may not be used to meet the Science Requirement in Program Types A, B or D.

ARCH 112.3, 116.3 may **not** be used to fulfill the Science Requirement.

Any senior-level Fine Arts course may be used provided that the prerequisite is met and not more than 6 credit units in one subject is used for the Fine Arts Requirement.

DRAM 121.3 may be used as an **elective** only.

### **General Requirement (Requirement #5 in Programs A, B, and C)**

With a few exceptions (including CLAS 103.3, 104.3, 106.3 and MATH 102.3), in Programs A, B, and C, any junior or senior course or combination of courses from the areas specified will meet Requirement 5. These courses must be Arts and Science courses.

### **Major Requirement (Requirement #6)**

For the most current course requirements in the major refer to the online Course and Program Catalogue at [www.usask.ca/programs/](http://www.usask.ca/programs/). A maximum number of credit units in one subject are allowed for the B.A. degree - B.A. Three-year: up to 42 credit units in one subject (at least 48 credit units must be in other subjects); B.A. Four-year and Honours: up to 60 credit units in one subject (at least 60 credit units must be in other subjects).

### **Electives Requirement (Requirement #7)**

Courses chosen by students out of interest, to strengthen their understanding of their major, or to complete a minor or Recognition in a Language. Some departments require their students to take certain electives in cognate subjects to the major. Students must ensure they have enough senior courses (200-level or higher): the Three-year degree requires at least 42 credit units in senior courses; the Four-year and Honours degrees requires at least 66 credit units in senior courses.

\* For non-Geography majors, a maximum of 6 credit units in Geography may be used in Requirements 1 – 5 for Program Types C and D and Requirements 1 – 4 for Program Types A and B.
