Learning Objectives

Students will begin to understand the history of art and culture in the ancient Mediterranean. They will learn about the different artistic styles of the four ancient cultures in the Museum and learn how they were different or similar. Students will also learn about the importance of replicas in the preservation of art and culture. They will also learn how to analyze an ancient myth in the activity pack.
