# THE PATRICIA CURRIE AWARD

This \$800 award is intended to recognize female students who are pursuing a four-year Bachelor of Science degree with a specialization in Chemistry and who have participated in extracurricular activities.

To be eligible for this award, the student must have completed at least two years towards their Bachelor of Science degree and have at least 21 credits in chemistry with an overall minimum GPA of 65%. She must have demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activities. These activities are not restricted and can vary from volunteering for aid organizations to sports participation to serving on student affairs committees (for example). Selection emphasis will however be towards activities that contribute to the quality of campus life.

Candidates must apply for the award in writing demonstrating that they meet the above requirement with special emphasis on involvement in extracurricular activities. The application deadline is October 31, 2017. Candidates must also arrange for a letter of recommendation highlighting these activities to be sent by October 31 to Ronda Duke, Department of Chemistry, University of Saskatchewan 110 Science Place, Saskatoon SK S7N 5C9.
