

NSERC Undergraduate Summer Research Awards 2024 Department of Chemistry

Qualified undergraduate students in chemistry or a related discipline are encouraged to gain **practical experience** in science by joining an active research program for the summer. NSERC USRA awards are prestigious and look great on a resume! The NSERC USRA program has additional award opportunities available for Indigenous and Black Student Researchers.

Apply for an NSERC USRA by **first** contacting a faculty member to sponsor your application. Applications include a *student application form* and a *faculty application form* that describes your research project. - Completed at least one year of studies
- Cumulative average of 70% or higher
- > Canadian citizen or permanent resident

Procedure to Apply for a 2024 NSERC USRA in the Department of Chemistry

- Select a Chemistry supervisor in an area of interest (https://artsandscience.usask.ca/chemistry/undergraduates/summer-research.php). Contact the faculty member to discuss the possibility of doing a summer research project and provide the faculty member with a copy of your unofficial advising transcript.
- 2. Go to the web page https://vpresearch.usask.ca/students/undergraduate/undergrad-research-opportunities/nserc-usras.php#ApplicationProcess for complete details on the application process. New in 2024 is that applications will be submitted through Canvas and students do not need to provide USask transcripts.
- 3. Send a copy of your application to Erin Wasylow, Department of Chemistry (erin.wasylow@usask.ca) or in Thorvaldson 165 (Chemistry main office).
