# **Comprehensive Exam – Quick Reference**

# **Exam Components**

#### **Literature Review**

- Short review on a topic from the current literature
- A critical analysis of the field and insights about remaining challenges
- 3,000 6,000 words total (including the proposal, not including references)

## **Research Proposal**

- Proposal for future research
- Must contain a clear research question
- Describe your methodology and experimental approach
- 1,000 2,000 words
  (approx. ¼ ⅓ of report)

### **Presentation**

- A presentation that covers both your review and your research proposal
- Open to everyone, but the primary audience is your advisory committee
- 25 30 min

#### **Question Period**

- Two rounds of questions based on your report and presentation
- Most questions will come from your advisory committe, but all faculty present may ask questions
- Approx. 60 120 min

# **Write Report**

Report is due 4
 weeks from topic
 approval

# Presentation and Questions

 1-2 weeks after report submission
