Emergency preparedness includes:

- ▶ Emergency Response Plan (document)
- Emergency risks poince Fair (dockdown)
 Emergency drills (fire and lockdown)
 AlertUs emergency notification system (installed in all buildings, all campus computers / telephones)
 Testing of safety equipment (fire alarms; safety showers; etc.)
 Other forms of education and awareness to aid in effective response to emergency situations

Emergency preparedness involves all individuals on campus. Every campus member has a right to a healthy and safe work or study environment and a responsibility to ensure campus or department protocols are adhered to.
