Abstract:

The Canada-Norway Student Sounding Rocket (CaNoRock) exchange program is a partnership between Andøya Space Center and several universities in Canada and Norway. For CaNoRock XXI, 22 students from the Universities of Oslo (Norway), Kobe, Kyushu (Japan), Alberta, Calgary, Saskatchewan, and Royal Military College (Canada) met for a week-long field course held at Andøya Space in Andenes, Norway. During the course, the students were tasked to assemble and test scientific sensors as well as learn about launching sounding rockets/weather balloons. The course culminated with the launch of a student sounding rocket containing the instruments assembled by the students. The four of us went on the CaNoRock course in early March this year, and this seminar will discuss our experiences on the course and the achieved outcomes.
