Application Process:

STEP 1): You must be admitted into the U of S College of Arts & Science and be in <u>at least</u> the second year of your studies and/or have equivalent life or employment experience before you can be considered for the CCAP.

STEP 2). Complete the application form and forward it to the address below. In addition to this application form, please submit:

- 1. CV or Resume
- 2. Most recent education institution transcript (if you are a current U of S student this is not required)
- List two reference contacts, (at least one academic). Please list name, title, email and/or phone number of references. Have references use the "reference request" form (below) and submit directly to ccap@usask.ca.

- 4. A letter of intent, which may include:
 - a) a brief introduction and statement about your interest in applying to the CCAP program;
 - b) your goals & objectives in completing the CCAP program. In this section, please include any initial thoughts about where you would like to complete your practicum placement and/or areas you would like to work within (i.e. youth justice, corrections/prisons, community centers, addictions; research practicum; etc.);
 - c) your timeline for completion of the CCAP program;
 - d) a few details about your academic goals, background and any related experience.
- 5. Confirmation that you will be able to do your 6-week full time practicum in May 2025. Most practicum placements will be completed in May 2025. If you are unable to complete your practicum at this time, please submit your application when you are able to do so.

STEP 3) The application deadline is **January 15, 2024**. You will receive notice of decision by April 30, 2024. If you have any questions, please contact <u>CCAP@usask.ca</u> or 306-966-2787.
